



- 4. Attach clamp rigs and bungee hook hasps to carrier. Logo should face out. For front legs, insert round bolt in front leg bolt hole, then screw into bolt hole on clamp rig. For rear leg, insert round bolt in smallest hole of hasp (hasp angled outwards, facing upward), then scew into bolt hole on clamp rig.
- 3. Determine leg height. Place carrier ove rear wheel and hold legs on seat stays. If cargo tray is not more or lesshorizontal, remove bolts on front legs, rear legs, or both to adjust carrier height and angle. Carrier must have at least 2 cm clearance over wheel.(fig 4)




CARRIER MOUNTING

- 1. Place clamp rigs near the midpoint along the seat stays, seating them on the inner face (fig 5)
- 2.Unstick Velcro straps, adjust length (see fig 6), wrap end of strap - with built in allen bolt - around seat stay and push them through the holes in the other side of the clamp.



3. Place square washers behind bolt heads, open side facing down (see fig 7).



- 4. Pull down on straps to tighten (see fig 8), and re-stick Velcro all the way around the seat stays (fig 9).
- 5. Using scissors, cut excess strap that may interfere with the wheel. Tighten bolts.
- 6. Adjust rear leg position(width) if necessary to center the carrier over the wheel (fig 10).
- 7. Once carrier is mounted correctly and length and angle adjustments have been made, check and tighten all bolts securely.
