Stem


Please read all instructions before installing and using your stem.

Be sure to install your stem using the appropriate tools in order to avoid damage to the fork steerer tube, stem and/or handlebar.

Installation/Use

- 1. Insert the fork steerer tube onto the head tube on the frame.
- 2. Slide the split ring onto the steerer tube and push it all the way down making sure a snug fit is obtained.
- 3. Slide the aluminum dust shield all the way down until it reaches the split ring.
- 4. Slide the necessary spacers needed to obtain a desirable height.
- 5. Slide the stem onto the remaining portion of steerer tube left.
- 6. While seating the steerer tube upward, and making sure a snug fit is obtained, screw the top cap to the star nut in the steerer tube.
- 7. Center the handlebar on the stem as shown in Fig. 2 and tighten the bolts in the sequence shown. You can refer to Manual HB-001 for proper instructions on how to install your handlebar.
- 8. Align the stem with the front wheel. Once straight, tighten the stem mount bolts to the appropriate torque suggested by manufacturer.

Warning <u></u>

- * Use the proper tools to install your stem and handlebar.
- * Check for play by pushing and/or pulling the handlebar from side to side and/or up and down once installed.
